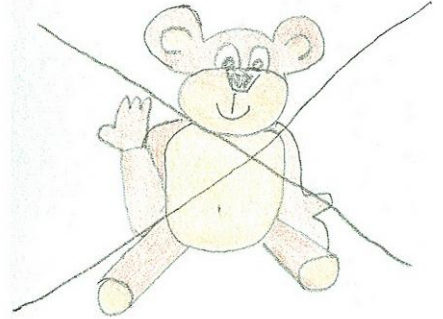
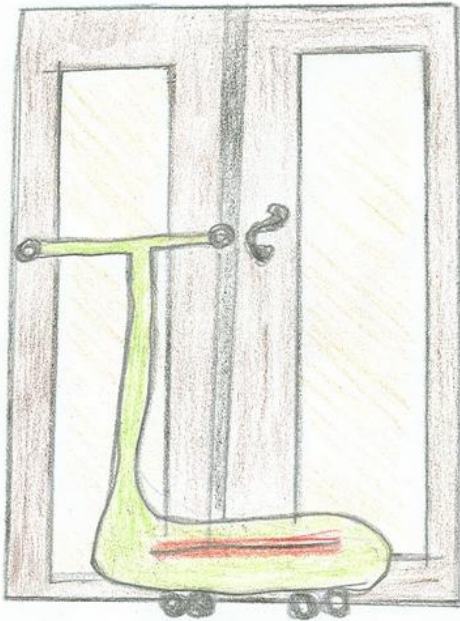

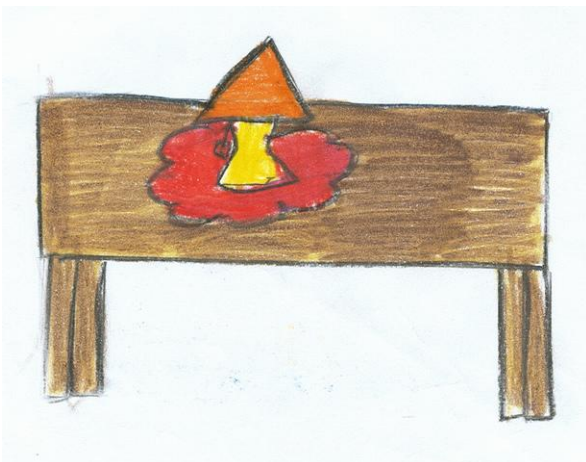
In my bedroom **there's** a a wardrobe, a table, a chair and a lamp.

I **have got** a scooter and a ball.

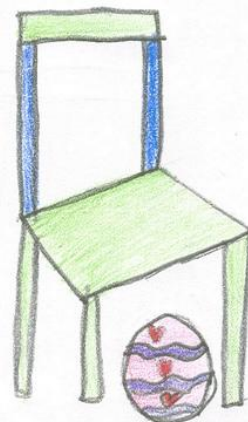

The kite is behind the drawers

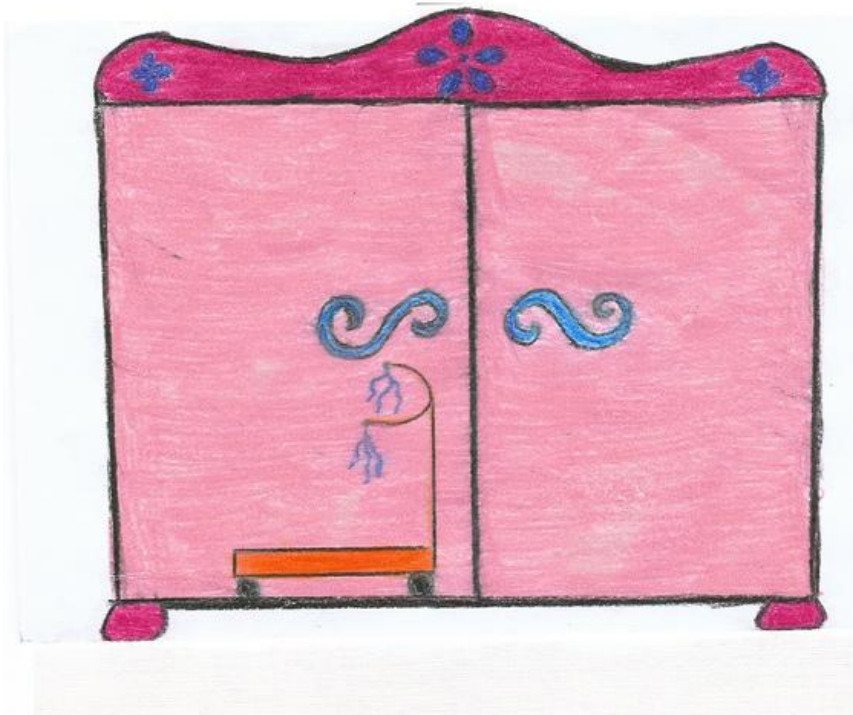
